

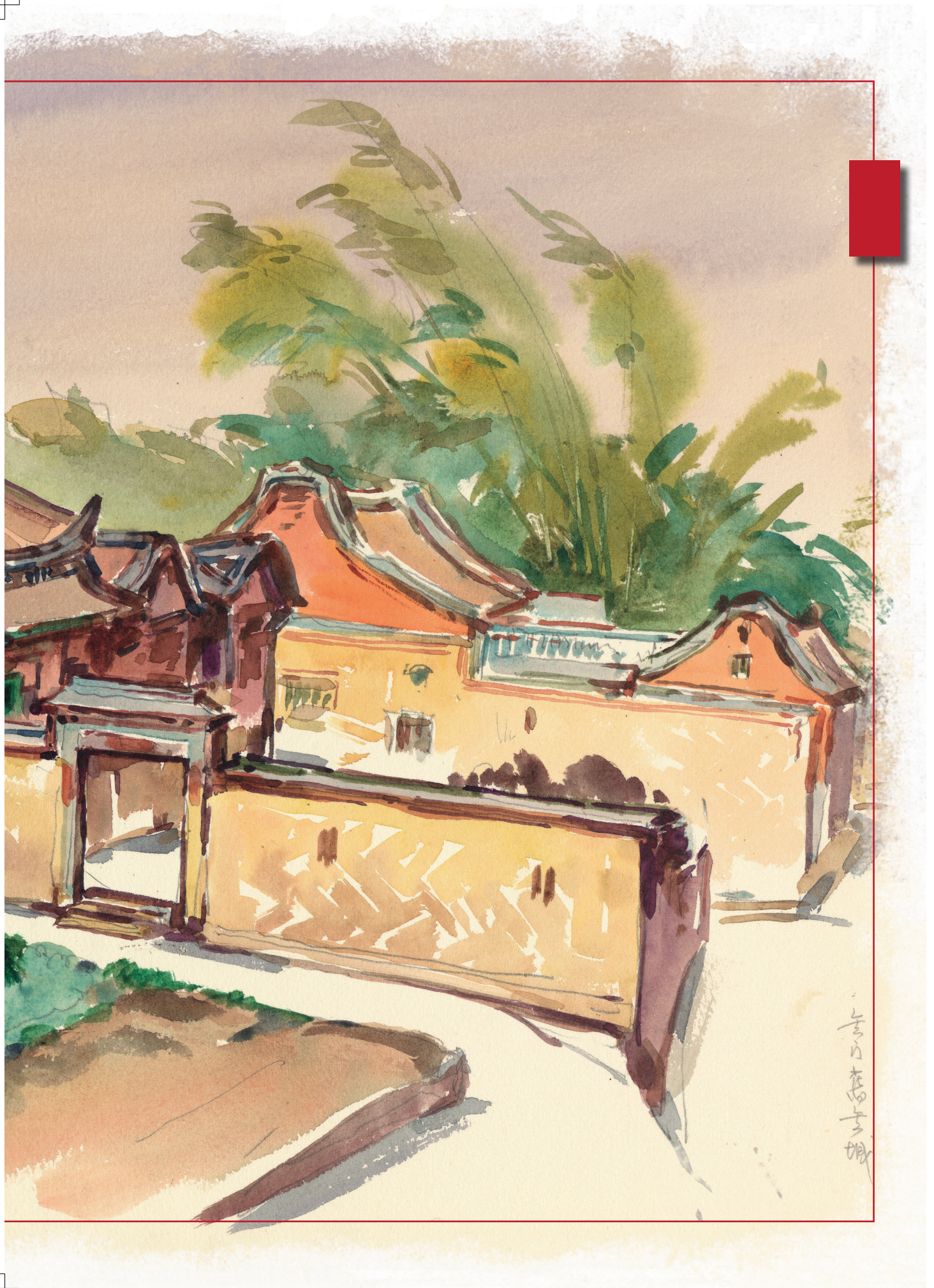

Historical Overview

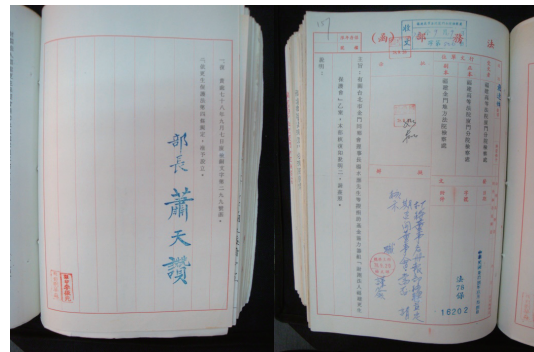


Section 1 The background

In early 1989, in order to strengthen the rehabilitation protection program and make the rehabilitation protection system more complete, the Ministry of Justice instructed the Xiamen Branch of the Fuchien High Court Prosecutors Office (i.e. the former name of the current Kinmen Branch of the Fuchien High Prosecutors Office) and the Fuchien Kinmen District Court Prosecutors Office (i.e. the former name of the current Fuchien Kinmen District Prosecutors Office) to jointly study and prepare for the establishment of the Fuchien Rehabilitation Protection Association, so as to develop the rehabilitation protection undertakings within its jurisdiction. On November 11, 1989, after eight months of study and preparation, the Fuchien Rehabilitation Protection Association was finally officially established (the date of the establishment was also known as the Rehabilitation Protection Day). This organization was under the direction and supervision of Ministry of Justice, handling the rehabilitation protection undertakings in Kinmen County and Lienchiang County.

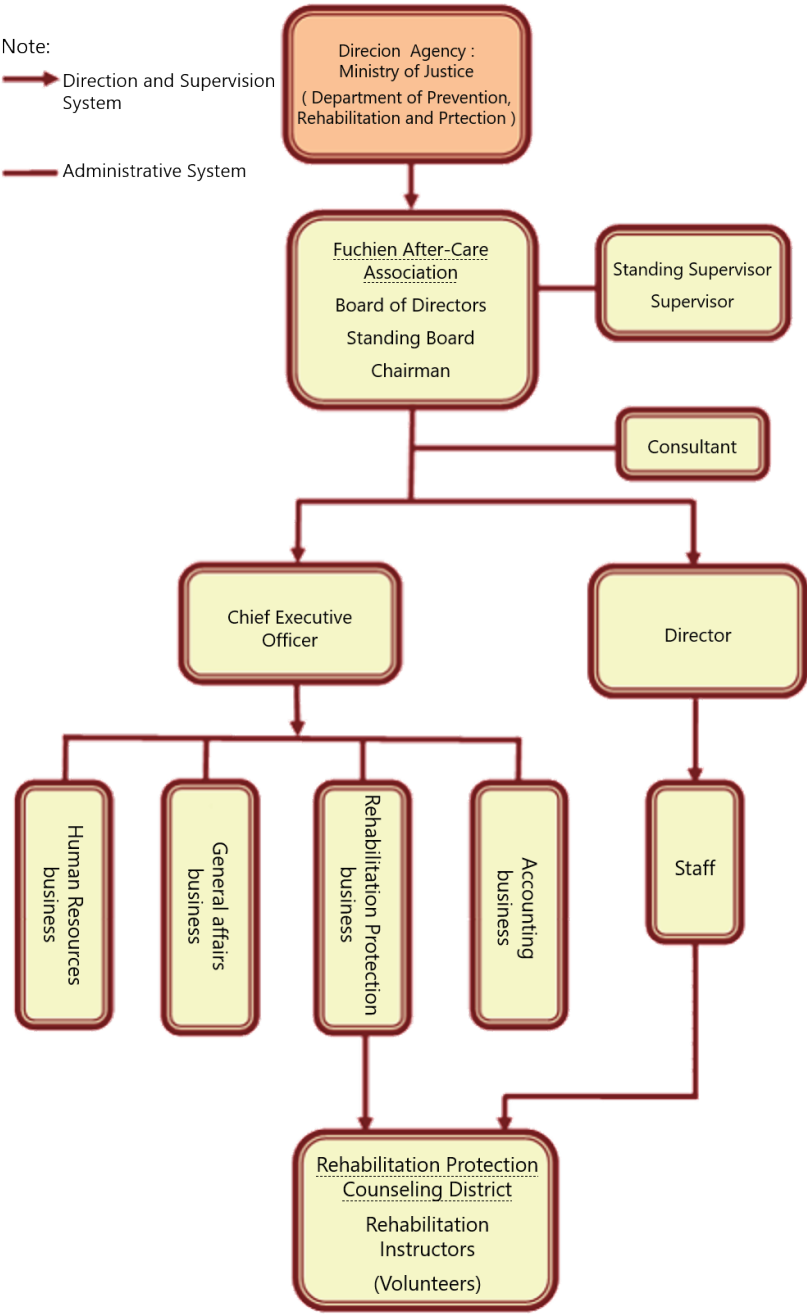

Chapter 2

Progression and Highlights of Important Business over the Years



2000 Program for extending the scope of counseling from the rehabilitation protection of the rehabilitated people to that of the family and family members of the rehabilitated people

The rehabilitation instructors established relationships with the family of the rehabilitated people in helping them resolve the non-economic difficulties due to the rehabilitated people's serving the sentence, as well as in counseling them to accept the rehabilitated person.

2004 Implementing rules for promoting the employers' employing the protected individuals by granting incentives

Finding third-party vendors in employing protected individuals where the incentives amounted to 5,000 NTD per rehabilitated person per month, up to a maximum of 12 months.

2006 Counseling program for lighting the lamp of vision by offering skills training

This program was listed by the Ministry of Justice in 2006 as one of the measures for the diverse rehabilitation protection assistance, including offering of the following skill training classes: ironwork skill class, motorcycle repairing class, thin noodles making class (the product was named "Ting Chin thin noodles" which meant full cooperation among the Prosecutors Office, the Prison, and the Taiwan After-care Association in Chinese), crystal bead modeling design class, and traditional food skill class, painting mounting skill class, etc.

2009 Key Points for Education (or Childcare) Subsidies for Children of Rehabilitated People

Subsidies were given to rehabilitated people's children of poor families, without receiving reduction, exemption, or subsidies of tuition and miscellaneous fees, so as to encourage these children's progress in completing their studies and to prevent these children from dropping out of school due to family economic factors.

2010 Program of Family Supportive Services for the Rehabilitated People by Rehabilitation Protection Association

This program provided home-return services for inmates and family support services for high-risk families of rehabilitated people. It aimed to help rehabilitated people overcome their life difficulties through family support and acceptance, and to help them and their families eliminate employment barriers, so as to ultimately promote their employment and life reconstruction.

2011 Twisted roll skill training (Lienchiang Prison Branch)

The Fuchien Rehabilitation Protection Association was responsible for purchase of the training equipment and food ingredients, and hired teacher Chang, Jui-Ping as the instructor. This training covered dough and material preparation, twist roll formation, roll frying in a pan, and mixing with the white sugar. With detail-oriented guidance throughout the course, inmates in Lienchiang area had the opportunity to acquire the skills with local characteristics for making a living.



2012 Program of Family Supportive Services for the Rehabilitated People by Rehabilitation Protection Association

This program provided home-return services for inmates and family support services for high-risk families of rehabilitated people. 2012 Fish-noodles skill training class (Lienchiang Prison Branch)

The famous teacher Li, Huo-Chin (known for her fish-noodles at Beigan, Matsu) was invited to visit Lienchiang Prison Branch as an advisor in noodle-making skills. The Fuchien Rehabilitation Protection Association was responsible for purchasing meat grinders, worktables, and other equipment. Ultimately, this skill training course with local characteristics of Lienchiang area was successfully developed.

2013 Mass production and commercialization of Matsu fish-noodles in Kinmen

The techniques of and formula for making Matsu fish-noodles were brought to Kinmen Prison for research and development of mass production. With the innovative taste of fish-noodles, market competitiveness was enhanced, and commercialization of the fish-noodles was ultimately achieved. This program benefited many prisoners who acquired skills with outlying islands characteristics that would help them make a living.

2013 Kinmen & Matsu Legal Chronicle

With the effort from the Kinmen Branch of the Fuchien High Prosecutors Office, the book "Kinmen & Matsu Legal Chronicle — Let the law shine and be passed down; Make Kinmen and Matsu under the rule of law" was successfully compiled for its 60th anniversary, which covered the history of the Fuchien Rehabilitation Protection Association, rehabilitation seminars, rehabilitation fora, and other flexible judiciary columns with nearly 100 pages. The book was 597 pages in total.

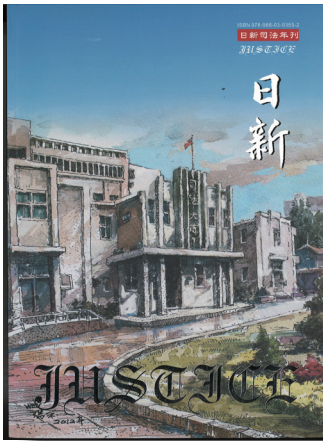


2013 Enabling the investment of the Association assets and injecting more funds for rehabilitation protection

A "Risk management mechanism for stock market investment" was studied and formulated to effectively control the stocks and investment benefits of the Rehabilitation Protection Association. Also, stocks with weak performance were eliminated and replaced with stocks with strong performance. In comparison with 2012, the energizing stock holding plan has increased to a cash dividend of 368,379 NTD. There was no cash dividend in 2012, so the investment return grew 100% in 2013.

2013 Preparing and issuing “library cards” to inmates in Lienchiang

As a pioneer, Lienchiang County Library prepared and issued library cards to the inmates, allowed book resources to be injected into the prison, and used its excellent book collections to broaden the reading horizons of the inmates. It was hoped that inmates could enrich themselves and prepare themselves for a new life after being released from prison.



2014 New Day -- 2014 Kinmen and Matsu Judicial Yearbook

In the Yearbook, reviews and strategies of judicial protection and prosecutorial affairs in the Kinmen and Matsu Districts were plotted, and more than 100 pages in the “Discussions and Treatises on Judicial Protection Business of Outlying Islands” were incorporated. Practitioners of judicial protection and experts and scholars in academia were widely invited to provide their specialized exposition. The contents of the Yearbook also included columns on military trial system, criminal law treatises, review of cross-strait legal system, public prosecution, special researches, and public security forums. Experts and scholars in both



judicial practice and academia worked together to drive judicial protection and judicial prosecutorial practice in the outlying islands through the systematic compilation of information. The Yearbook consisted of 574 pages, and was released in January 8, 2014.

2012 Lieyu grandma's sesame flatbread

With tens of years of experience in making and selling Chinese pastry in her home town Lieyu, Grandma Sun, Chiung-Chiao, as an invited instructor, selflessly imparted the skills of making Southern Fuchien-style sesame flatbread. She even creatively launched a unique sweet sesame flatbread with a brown sugar filling. In addition, Mr. Chen, Li-Che, a world champion dessert chef, was once invited to offer instruction. Both traditional savory sesame flatbread and creative sweet sesame flatbread demonstrated their unique flavors. With a substantial mouth-feel, these sesame flatbreads were often in high demand.

2014 Ting Chin Noodle and Pastry Store

Located in the Jincheng office, this Ting Chin Noodle and Pastry Store was a place to demonstrate and sell the products made at Kinmen Prison. The venue was provided by the Kinmen Branch of the Fuchien High Prosecutors Office, and the full-time staff of the Association was responsible for the management of the store. As a pioneer nationwide, this store was the first premises showcasing products made by inmates, with voluntary assistance from the Rehabilitation Protection Association. Located in the administrative and commercial center of Kinmen, this store not only enjoyed a high product visibility, but also allowed organizations and people in the Jincheng area to easily pick up their goods within proximity. This store showed a promising promotion effect. The products were also widely praised, which greatly enhanced the inmates' sense of achievement for their work and helped build the inmates' self-confidence in returning to the society.

2014 Promoting special counseling for people with alcohol addiction

For people with alcohol addiction who were serving their sentences and under custody, correction treatment for rectifying their alcohol addiction was imposed on and rational abstinent drinking

concept was inculcated while the government could still exert restrictions on them. When such treatment was implemented in an institution, various restrictions and interference factors related to time and work could be eliminated, thus improvement became easier than in the community. The aim of such implementation was to reduce excessive drinking and improper behavior and to reshape a way for a new independent life.

2014 Strengthening the performance of the leasing operation on the building for rehabilitated people

There were 26 suites available for lease in the building for rehabilitated people. In view of the increasingly competitive market of student housing over the year, the main client could be

geared from the student-oriented to a focus on other potential renter groups, so as to respond to the market change in the future. After actively contacting potential customers in the industrial and commercial circle, the whole building was fully leased for a long term (of three years) beginning September, 2014. This result indeed brought about substantial benefits in helping the financial health and reducing management costs. Total rents had increased 63% (equivalent to 630,000 NTD approximately).

2014 Spring of the blue tears — Lienchiang Counseling Collection

Since Chairman Hsing, Tai-Chao took office, he has been deeply cultivating the rehabilitation protection affairs for three years. This collection fully recorded the journey in the form of chronology and featured articles, so as to facilitate the inherence of experience. On July 16, 2014, the first edition of the 80-page collection was published. On March 24, 2015, the second edition of the 187-page collection was published. On May 4, 2015, the 152-page book "Spring of the blue tears" (Matsu Chapter) was published, and consisted of the history of the Association, experience inheritance, seminars held in Kinmen and Matsu, rehabilitation fora, chronology, and future prospects, etc., thus properly compiling and well preserving the performance of the deeply cultivated rehabilitation protection in the jurisdictions of Kinmen and Matsu.

2015 Introduction of university instructors to counsel rehabilitated people on starting a business

Since 2015, resources of National Quemoy University were introduced, and professors of business management background were invited, so that rehabilitated people could gain assistance in formulating an overall business

strategy in the beginning of the business on the operation, marketing, and development, etc., so as to give rehabilitated people a friendly environment in which to successfully start their business.

2016 Individual counseling plan for juveniles involved in drugs in Kinmen area

In this plan, experienced clinical psychologists in Taiwan were introduced to Kinmen. Through individual counseling, drug-using juveniles with adaptation needs could be guided to clarify their thinking, understand their problem, and further improve their cognitive thinking, rectify their bad behavior, and get rid of their drug addiction problems.

2017 Group counseling plan for juveniles involved in drugs to embrace the sunshine

In this plan, leaders of professional groups conducted group counseling by guiding drug addicted individuals in prison, detention centers, or the community in the form of mutual discussion and sharing, so as to help group members in self-exploration, knowing oneself, learning self-assertion, enhancing stress coping abilities and skills, looking for significant others' support, and further strengthening motivation to cut the drug tie and embrace the sunshine.

Counseling psychologists were in place to assist group members in getting to know themselves and life, strengthening their self-discipline function, establishing a space for dialogue with their family,

society and themselves, so that the group members could transform into a healthy receptor to receive and absorb the resources and love from the external world, and further re-position themselves and settle down again with the right direction in life without the struggle with drugs.

2018 Lienchiang Chinese Dim Sum Class

In Lienchiang Prison Branch, various Chinese dim sum skills training at a professional level were offered, such as classes on beef noodles, golden dumplings, Chinese omelets, fried dumplings, and dumplings, so that inmates

could have the opportunity to learn skills in Matsu where resources were relatively scarce.

2019 Chinese Noodles Class

Mr. Tsai, Yu-Hsueh, a winner of 2017 "Proud of Taiwan — Industry leader" award, was invited to teach the cooking skills of fried dumplings, steamed buns, scallion pancakes, pastry with shredded radish, Kinmen lucky pastry, etc. A series of courses, including subjects such as food hygiene and safety, creative marketing, and vocational training, were arranged to facilitate the employment and start-up of the class members after they are released from prison.

Mr. Lin, Hsin-Kuang, owner of the Hecheng Pastry Store in Lieyu Township, was repeatedly interviewed in various tourism and gourmet programs on TV, such as "iWalker," "Career Master," "Stay Local, Think Global," and by other Internet celebrities. In this Dim Sum Class, Lin, Hsin-Kuang selflessly shared the skills of making red bean paste cakes and crispy bite pastry. The finished products were not inferior to the products on the market in terms of taste, quality and packaging, which were equipped with market competitiveness.

2021 Pandemic relief and care under COVID-19

The COVID-19 pandemic has had a huge impact on society and economy. Particularly, while the inmates' were serving their sentences, the family has lost a part of their household income. If the work of the family members is further affected by the pandemic, the situation would only get worse. In addition to actively assisting family members in employment, the Association also uses various methods, such as "Predicament Relief Procurement Group," "Anti-pandemic Essential Pack," "Emergency Relief Fund," "Scholarships and Grants," "School Textbook", etc., to provide customized assistance depending on respective needs case-by-case.

Chapter 3

Future Prospects



The jurisdiction of the Association covered Kinmen County and Lienchiang County where the transportation and contact was relatively inconvenient, and the mother tongues and customs were diverse. There were only three full-time staff, and resources were also limited. However, under the guidance of the Ministry of Justice and the leadership of the past Chairmen, along with resources from all sectors of society, rehabilitation protection work received encouragement and support, and the business was able to run smoothly.

In the future, social resources are to be utilized continuously, the lineup of rehabilitation instructors is to be strengthened, and in compliance with the Ministry of Justice's "Family assistance" and "Thorough judicial protection" policies, a thorough counseling strategy will be adopted from the time the protected individual serves the sentence to returning to society. The Association shall also strengthen the individual's working ability, rebuild family support relationship, and improve effectiveness of counseling mentorship. By constantly promoting the concept of rehabilitation protection through the media, we hope to receive support and recognition from the public, enable the public to understand the meaning of rehabilitation protection and willingly accept and give a hand. To the end, it is hoped that those rehabilitated people who intend to convert towards a positive life could all return to and be accepted by society, which is the vision of the Association and what the Association has been aiming at.
