

In the case where the KMT Legislative Yuan (The Congress) Caucus accused government heads of alleged abuse in special fees, the Special Investigation Division of The Supreme Prosecutors Office already completed and concluded Phase I investigation. Nine government officials, including former Minister of the Interior Mr. Lee Yi-yang and his secretary Ms. Yang Hsiu-ying, Minister of Education Tu Cheng-sheng and his secretary Ms. Kuo Hsiu-hsia, Minister of Justice Mr. Shih Mao-lin and his Office Director Mr. Tang Hui-tung, secretary Ms. Chang Su-li, Minister of Examination Mr. Lin Chia-cheng and Minister of the Civil Service Mr. Chu Wu-hsien were indicted in the conclusion. Six others, i.e., former Vice Premier Ms. Tsai Ying-wen, Minister of Foreign Affairs Mr. Huang Chih-fang and his wife, Minister of Economic Affairs Mr. Chen Jui-lung, Minister of Finance Mr. Ho Chih-chin and Minister of Transportation & Communications Mr. Tsai Tui proved to have been backed with no concrete criminal facts and were not indicted in the concluded investigation.
