Service Mr. Chu Wu-hsien were indicted in the conclusion. Six others, i.e.,

former Vice Premier Ms. Tsai Ying-wen, Minister of Foreign Affairs Mr.

Huang Chih-fang and his wife, Minister of Economic Affairs Mr. Chen

Jui-lung, Minister of Finance Mr. Ho Chih-chin and Minister of

Transportation & Communications Mr. Tsai Tui proved to have been backed

with no concrete criminal facts and were not indicted in the concluded investigation.
